

**Tales of Self-Defense**

"A Washington Post story (7/15/2000) reports how in 1993 the Rev. Michael R. The priest took out a 9mm pistol, flipped on a light and ordered the intruder to freeze and lie on the floor. The

The priest fired a third time, deliberately wide of his target. The man ran out the side door escaping with a small amount of cash. The Post says this incident 'contrasts sharply' with the June, 2000, 'brutal slaying' of Monsignor Thomas Wells at the Mother Seaton Catholic Church in Germantown, Maryland, who died after being repeatedly stabbed. The difference between these two events is that Monsignor Wells was unarmed."

## **Women & Children First**

### **College Crime Statistics on the Web**

Parents and students can now use the Internet to review crime statistics for college and university campuses at a new U.S. Education Department Web site.

"Safety is certainly a concern for parents and students in selecting a college," said then-U.S. Secretary of Education Richard W. Riley. "This is the next step in making such information readily available."

Crime statistics for more than 600 U.S. colleges, universities and career schools have been posted at <http://ope.ed.gov/security>. Data for some 6,000 additional

postsecondary education institutions will be posted as they are received. The deadline was Oct. 17.

By law, colleges and universities are required to collect campus crime statistics and distribute an annual security report to current students and employees and, on request, to prospective students. Under the 1998 Higher Education Amendments, the department is now required to collect crime data from colleges and make the statistics publicly available.

Postsecondary institutions are expected to report all incidences of criminal homicide, manslaughter, sex offenses, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, motor vehicle theft and arson. Institutions must also report hate crimes. Institutions are also required to report separate statistics for each campus and denote where the crime occurred.

The statistics must also include arrests for illegal weapons possession and liquor and drug law violations, including the number of persons referred for campus disciplinary action for these violations.

This is timely information, especially since some on the political left have been calling for the Federal government to limit handgun possession to those 21 and older. How many college-age daughters would such a law make vulnerable and defenseless? Think about that as you read these stats!
